Aboriginal: A person who has been living in a land from the earliest times; in Canada, aboriginal peoples are First Nations, Inuit and Metis.



Archeologist: A person who studies the past by digging into Earth to discover where people once lived, and examining the objects found there.



Artifact: An object that was made by people, especially from the past.





Curator: A person at a museum who is responsible for museum exhibits and collections of artifacts.




Descendant: A person who is related to someone or a group of people from the past.





Excavate: to dig into the soil.

Historical Evidence: The primary or secondary sources that historians use to prove events of the past.



Primary Source: a first-hand account (eg. diaries, letters) created by someone based on their experiences; also, artifacts such as spearheads, pottery, armor).




